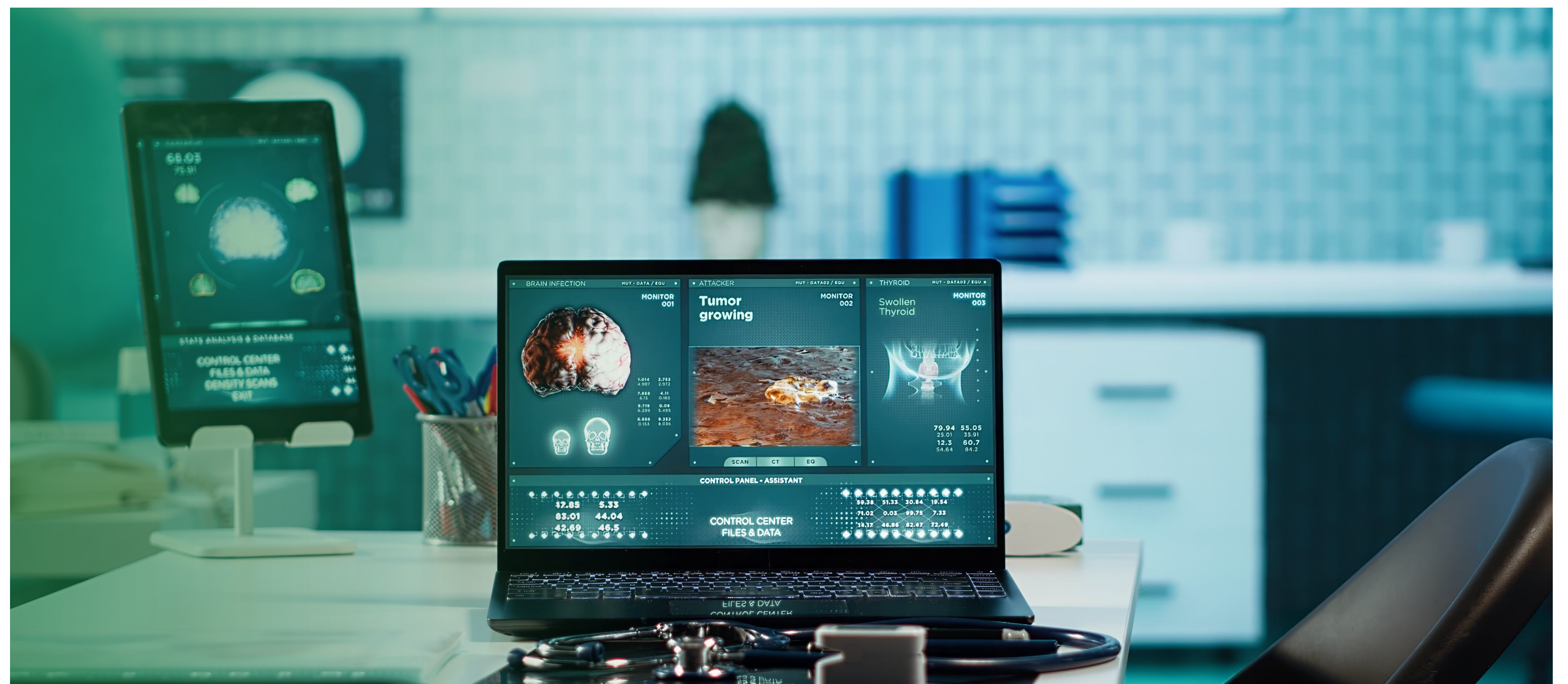

The challenge

The hospital system's facilities team had warehouses full of decommissioned monitors, workstations, and imaging equipment that had built up over several years across multiple campuses. With a renovation coming up, they needed the space cleared, and they needed a recycler who could process everything responsibly and prove it, without the project dragging on for months.

The background

Recycle Technologies operates R2v3-certified facilities in Minnesota and Wisconsin under a strict no-landfill policy. Rather than sending anything to a landfill, the company breaks down electronics into their base materials- metals, plastics, glass, and circuit boards- so each material can go on to its proper downstream use.

Recycle Technologies coordinated pickups across all of the hospital system's campuses at once, consolidating what would normally be separate building-by-building jobs into a single project. Every device was logged in on arrival and processed at Recycle Technologies' certified facility, with over 14,000 pounds of electronics diverted from landfill in under six weeks. Once the project wrapped up, the hospital system received a certificate of recycling for every load, giving its facilities and compliance teams a complete paper trail without any extra work on their part.

"We had no idea how much space we'd been losing to old equipment until it was gone," said the hospital system's facilities director. "Recycle Technologies handled the whole thing without us managing separate trucks or paperwork for each building."
